On behalf of the Zuni McKinley County Fair Committee and the parade sponsors, the Cellicion Traditional Zuni Dancers, would like to welcome all to the 2011 Zuni Fair Parade. We, the Cellicion Dancers are honored to sponsor this years Zuni Fair Parade once again. We hope everyone will have a safe, successful and fun event.

Following are the parade rules, the judging criteria and additional information. Please read carefully.

PLEASE wear or place the parade number on the right side of banner, vehicle, or on one of your group members, make sure it's visible. IF THROWING CANDY or ITEMS.

PLEASE THROW FAR AWAY FROM THE VEHICLE.

ALL ENTRANTS MUST PAUSE AT THE JUDGES STAND TO BE JUDGED,

AT THE JUDGES STAND LOOK FOR (2) MONITORS WHICH ARE LOCATED BEFORE AND AFTER THE JUDGING AREA. THE FIRST MONITOR WILL LEAD THE ENTRANTS INTO THE JUDGING AREA, THE SECOND MONITOR AT THE END OF THE JUDGING AREA WILL BE THE ONE TO LOOKOUT FOR, THIS MONITOR WILL BE KEEPING TIME AND WILL BE GIVEN A SIGN FROM THE HEAD JUDGE THAT THE JUDGING HAS BEEN COMPLETED, THE SECOND MONITOR WILL THEN INFORM YOU THAT THE JUDGING IS COMPLETE AND MOVE ALONG, DANCE GROUPS MAY DO A SHORT DANCE FOR THE JUDGES, BUT KEEP IT SHORT (UNDER 5 MINUTES) DEDUCTIONS MAY BE ENFORCED IF TO LONG. BE ON THE LOOKOUT FOR THE MONITORS.

Judging Criteria: (Point System will be used)

- **ROYALTY/DIGNATARY** – Attire: Poise, “Speech” Audience.
Can introduce themselves, sing song, etc.
- **MARCHING DIVISION** – Uniform, step, formations, audience
- **FLOAT DIVISION** – Creativity, originality, theme, Audience
- **DANCE GROUP DIVISION** – “Regalia, Song & Rhythm, In-sync, Audience.
Must be in full traditional regalia/clothing. Points deducted if wearing T-shirt, tennis shoes, (dress shirt, boots are excepted)

Sunglasses may be worn during the parade but has to be taken off during judging.

Prescription glasses only!

PA system will be set up at the judges stand to announce the entrants into the judging area.

For you convenience water stops will be setup along the parade route.

1st, 2nd, and 3rd place trophies will be awarded in all divisions plus a six foot “Overall Grand Champion Sweepstakes trophy” will be awarded to the entrant with the highest overall points. A travel trophy will be awarded to the entrant who traveled the furthest. **Please line up according to numbers. 1,2,3, and so on. Listen for your number, numbers will be announced to get your entry into the parade line**

ALL ENTRANTS MUST BE CHECKED IN BY 9:00 AM. THE PARADE STARTS PROMPLY AT 10:00 AM SHARP! WITH or WITHOUT YOU!! NO INDIAN TIME!!!
